his heirs and assigns forever, those two certain pieces, parcels or tracts of land situate lying and being in Deruklin Township, Greenville County, South Carolina and described as follows: First Tract: Beginning at a stone on the west bank of Horse Creek, and running thence with said Creek N. 5 1/2 W. about 45 chains to a stone on the southwest bank of said Creek; thence S. 20 W. 23.20 to a stone 3 x 7 m, thence S. 73 E. 23.10 to a stone 3 x 7 m; thence S. 86 E. 6.00 to a chain; thence N. 86 E. 18.26 to a stone on west bank of said Creek, the beginning corner, and containing sixty-three and three-fifths (63 3/5) acres, more or less, and more fully described in plat of survey by Jas. P. Willis, made Nov. 12 1900, and known as tract No. 12 of the lands sold by J. W. Gray Master, in the case of G. A. Holwood vs. J. W. Sullivan et al. and being the same land conveyed by E.
