Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

Merchants and Planters National Bank, all that certain piece
 parcel or lot of land situated in the state and county aforesaid
 in Section twelve of the city Greenville, known as North Dauci Villa
 and being known as lot no. 55 as shown by survey of W. A.
 Cidarus, August 25, 1911 and plat of said survey being recorded in
 office of R. M. C. for Greenville County in Plat Book "A" pages 510
 and 511 and having the following lines and boundaries to-wit:

Beginning at a stake on the West side of Furman Road,
 joint corners with lot no. 56 and running thence with said lot
