All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, Township of O'Neal and having the following metes and bounds to wit: Beginning on a stone Bulls corner and running thence N. 29 1/4 W. 4.18 to a stone; thence along settlement road leading from Sandy Flat to J. A. Covall 12.35 along said road to a stone (new corner) thence S. 2 1/2 E. 37.80 to a stone on old road; thence S. 45 1/2 W. 6.85 to a stone in road; thence S. 57 W. 3.65 to a stake in branch on said road back to the Bull corner; thence S. 44 1/2 E. 11.60 to a stone; thence S. 45 E. 10.78 to a poplar; thence S. 43 1/2 E. 18.24 to stake in branch the beginning corner, and containing 56 1/10 acres, more or less, and bounded by lands of R.
