at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

Piedmont Lumber Stock Company, its successors and assigns, All that tract, piece or parcel of land situated and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and on the waters of South Pacolet River, adjoining the lands of J. J. Gosnell, Frances Lindsey and others and being a part of the Levi Ward Lands beginning at a poplar and said Wards line at a branch and running S. 68 E. 51 chains to a pine; thence S. 43 E. 20 chains to a pine, thence S. 10 E. 10 1/2 chains to a red oak on Wards line thence with said Wards line 60 West 26 chains to a chestnut oak, thence N. 45 W. 9 chains to a forked red oak, thence N. 80 W. 32 chains to a poplar on branch, the beginning corner, and containing 60 acres more or less, and being the land conveyed to me by Margaret Holcomb, May Moore, Cofa Seay, Minnie Bates, Mattie Evans and George Gosnell and recorded in Book 36 at page 164 in office of R.
