

TOGETHER with all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any-wise incident or appertaining.

And I myself my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Mrs. L. G. Compton, her heirs and assigns, from and against myself my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, and every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

AND the said mortgagee agrees to insure the house and buildings on said lot in the sum of not less than Seven Hundred Dollars, and keep the same insured from loss or damage by fire and assign the policy of insurance to the said Mrs. L. G. Compton and that in the event the mortgagor shall at any time fail to do so, then the said mortgagee may cause the same to be insured in her name, and reimburse herself for the premium and expense of such insurance under this mortgage.

Compton the said debt or sum of money aforesaid, with interest thereon if any shall be due, according to the true intent and meaning of the said notes then this deed of bargain and sale shall cease, determine and be utterly null and void; otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.

AND IT IS AGREED, By and between the said parties, that I am to hold and enjoy the said premises until default of payment shall be made.
