Said principal payable one year from date. For all of which I have given my note of even date herewith; said note also provides for ten (10) per cent Attorney's fees.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, W.L. Kennemore.....

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said H.P. McGee..... according to the terms

in hand well and truly paid by the said H.P. McGee..... at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

H.P. McGee, his heirs and assigns, all that piece, parcel or lot of land in the City and County of Greenville, South Carolina, on the northeast side of a forty foot Street, and beginning at a point on said Street 136 feet and 6 inches N.W. from Green Ave.; at the corner of Lot No. 9, and runs thence N. 27 E. 153 feet 6 inches; thence N. 63 W. 46 feet and 6 inches; thence in a straight line 154 feet and 2 inches to a point on said forty foot Street; thence S. 57.45 E. along said Street 54 feet to the beginning corner, being Lot No. 8 of the Nelson property as shown by a plat of Adams dated October 5th, 1910 and conveyed to me by deed of even date by Maude Eskew, said deed not yet recorded.
