Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said Carrie R. Laws and Lizzie L. Dantzler:-

All of that certain piece, parcel or tract of land, containing One hundred and thirty acres, more or less, situate, lying and being in Paris Mountain Township, County and State aforesaid, and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at a stone XOM on Earle's line on Farr's Mill Road, and running thence N. 58 E. 16.08 chains to a stake XOM on said Road; thence N. 38-3/4 E. 12.75 chains to stake XOM; thence N. 16-1/2 E. 7.65 chains to stake XOM on aforesaid Farr's Mill Road; thence S. 77-1/2 E. 5.65 chains to stone XOM across Reedy River, near bridge; thence N. 77 E. 4.50 chains to stone XOM; thence N. 83-1/2 E. 25.05 chains to stake NM; thence S. 54 W. 16 chains to stake in center of bridge across aforesaid Reedy River; thence S. 60 W. 12.30 chains to P.O. NM (Dead); thence N. 87-1/2 W. 26.50 chains to a stone XOM; thence N. 40-3/4 12.15 chains to the beginning corner and being the same tract of land conveyed to the said Jas. R. Crouch and J.C. Redmon by Thomas M. Hunt by his deed of conveyance dated the 24th, day of December 1919, and recorded in Book 48, page 56 in the office of the R.M.C. for Greenville County, and being the same tract of land in which the said J.C. Redmon conveyed to the said Jas. R. Crouch his (J.C. Redmon's) half interest by his deed of conveyance bearing date the 27th, day of August, 1923 and recorded in Book 88, page 414 in the office of the R.M.C. for Greenville County.
