with interest thereon from this date at the rate of seven per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose the mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place, and the holder should place, the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses, including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorney's fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land, lying, being and situate in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, just north of the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, on the north side of Hill Crest Drive and being known and designated as lots 5 and 6 of Section 8 of the Hindman property as will appear by reference to plat recorded in Plat Book 6 Page 101, and being more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a stake on the north side of said Hill Crest Drive, at corner of lot 4 and running thence with line of lot no. 4 N 9-52 E. 190 feet to stake on 15 foot alley; thence with line of said alley N. 80-08 W. 100 feet to stake corner of lot 7; thence with line of lot 7, S 9-52 W. 190 feet to stake on Hill Crest Drive; thence with Hill Crest Drive, S 80-08 E. 100 feet to the beginning corner.

Being the same lots of land purchased by me from Lucy L. Hindman, on December 1st. 1919. It is understood that this mortgage is a second mortgage over the above described lots, the mortgage this day executed by me to the Citizens Trust Company for \$6000.00 being the first mortgage.
