When paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time not paid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place, and the holder should place, the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses, including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorney's fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

Dillard, September 30th 1896, as will appear by deed recorded Vol. CCC page 398 in office R. M. C. for Greenville County, South Carolina and described in said deed as lot nos 12 and 13. Lot no. 12 fronting on Forest Street 110 feet and running back 115 feet to Lots nos 1 and 2 bounded on the north by lots nos. 1 and 2, on the east by lot no. 13 and lot formerly Mrs. Stewart, on the west by lot no 3 and on the south by Forest Street, Lot no 13 fronting 48 feet on Bailey Street and runs back 150 feet along Forest Street to lot no 12 and is bounded on the north by lot formerly Mrs. Stewart on the east by Bailey Street, on the south by Forest Street and on the west by lot no. 12. Being the same Lots conveyed to W. D. Parish and T. C. Gower by W. W. Burgess by deed dated Sept 23rd 1919 and recorded in Vol. 49 page 240 and from W. D. Parish and T. C.
