WHEREAS, I, *A. F. Alexander*

am well and truly indebted to *Bank of Conestee*
in the full and just sum of *Thirteen Hundred Fifty-Seven & 37/100*

Dollars, in and by *my* certain promissory note *as set forth below* in writing, of even date herewith, due and payable on the *note for Five Hundred (\$500.00)*
Day of *Feb. 7, 1920* and due *Nov. 15th, 1920*; *note for One Hundred Eight (\$108.00) dollars*
dated Mar. 18th, 1920 and due Nov. 15th, 1920; *note for One Hundred Eight (\$108.00) dollars dated May 24th*
1920 and due Nov. 15th, 1920; *note for \$55.00 fifty five dollars dated July 22nd and due Nov. 15th, 1920*;
note for Five Hundred Eighty-Six & 37/100 dollars, (\$586.37) dated Dec. 18th, 1920 and
due March 18, 1921 with interest from *maturity*

at the rate of *Eight* per centum per annum until paid; interest to be computed and paid *Semi* annually
and if unpaid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal until paid, and I have further
promised and agreed to pay ten per cent. of the whole amount due for attorney's fees, if said note be collected by an attorney or through legal proceedings of any
kind, reference being hereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, *A. F. Alexander*

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better
securing the payment thereof according to the terms of the said note and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me
in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and
released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *Bank of Conestee*

all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in *Grove*
Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

conveyed to me by Etta Jameson by deed dated Feb. 1, 1918
recorded in Vol. 42 page 262 office of R. M. C. containing
Sixty-Seven and 1/100 acres more or less and adjoining
the lands of W. J. Rhodes, J. A. Alexander, E. C. Garrison and
James Kiddle. In consideration of the fact that certain
of the above mentioned notes are past due and the
time for payment has been extended until Mar. 18, 1921
this mortgage is given as additional security to the
above mentioned notes.
