 in the full and just sum of *Two Thousand Dollars (\$2000)*,
 Dollars, to be paid *Five years from the date hereof*,
 with interest thereon from *January first of next year* at the rate of *Eight* per cent. per annum, to be
 computed and paid *quarterly*, until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at
 any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon
 and foreclose this mortgage, and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before
 its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place, and the holder should place, the said note or this
 mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses, including
 10..... per cent. of the indebtedness as attorney's fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this
 mortgage as a part of said debt.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,
 bargain, sell and release unto the said *J. M. Andrea*,

All that certain tract of land situated on the west side of the state road in O'Neal Township, in the county and state aforesaid having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at an iron pine in said road corner of J. C. Nightower, thence with Nightower's line in westerly direction to the rock corner, thence still with Nightower's line in a southwesterly direction to stake on branch near large poplar, thence still with Nightower's line in westerly direction to a large pine stump; thence with Ellis' line in a northerly direction to a rock corner on top of hill; thence with Ellis' line in a westerly direction to a rock corner on top of hill; thence with Ellis' line in a northeasterly direction to stake on Gully, J. C. Cox's corner, thence with Cox's line in an easterly direction to state road. thence along said road to the beginning corner, containing fifty (50) acres, more or less, bounded by J. C. Nightower on the south, W. J. Ellis on the west, J. C. Cox for the north and by J. C. Cox and P. E. Flynn on the east and being the same land conveyed to me by E. M.
