SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, *S. J. Casey*, the saidin and by *my* certain *prossesory note* in writing, of
even date with these presents, *Am* well and truly indebted toin the full and just sum of *Sixty-five Thousand Dollars*
Dollars, to be paid *as follows* to wit *\$3,250.00* and accrued
interest on the whole sum on the 1st of July 1921,
and *\$3,250.00* and accrued interest on the 1st of
July, 1922.with interest thereon from *Date* *Annually* at the rate of *7* per cent. per annum, to be
computed and paid.until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at
any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon
and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before
its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to sue, and the holder should place, the said note or this
mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceeding; then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses, including
10 per cent. of the indebtedness an attorney's fee, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this
mortgage as a part of said debt.NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That *S. J. Casey*, the saidin consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment hereof to the said *Alvin H. Dean*according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to *Mrs. S. J. Casey*, the said *Alvin H. Dean*
in hand, well and truly paid by the said *Alvin H. Dean*at and before the signing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant,
bargain, sell and release unto the said *Alvin H. Dean*

all that lot or parcel of land in the city of Greenville, being fully described in Deeds made by H. J. Haynesworth et al to Alvin H. Dean. Said Deeds being recorded respectively in Book C, Page 195, Book P. P. D. Page 186, Book R. P. D. Page 187.

Said lot of land being accurately described in said deeds to Alvin H. Dean by H. J. Haynesworth et al as follows:

All that lot or parcel of land situate in the County and State aforesaid on the West side of Buckner Street in the city of Greenville and having the following mite and bounds:

Beginning at a point on Buckner street where line of Mrs. Tindal's property intersects said street; thence with Buckner street N. 41 $\frac{3}{4}$ E. 468.8 to an alley; thence with said alley S. 57 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 107 feet to a point thence continuing with said alley N. 88 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 246 feet to a point in corner of alley and line of Long's property; thence with line of last mentioned lots and property of Mrs. Tindal's S. 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ E. 350 feet to the beginning corner. Being the same lot of land this day conveyed by the said Alvin H. Dean to S. J. Casey, and this mortgage being given to secure a portion of the purchase price of said property.
