WHEREAS, we, the said Pauline M. Epstein and Phillip E. Levy

in and by our two certain promissory notes in writing, of even date with these presents, are well and truly indebted to

W.D. Parrish and P.C. Gower

in the full and just sum of Ten Thousand (\$10,000.00)

Dollars, to be paid as follows: Five Thousand (\$5,000.00) Dollars on April 1st, 1922 and Five Thousand (\$5,000.00) Dollars on April 1st, 1923.

with interest thereon from January 1st, 1921 at the rate of 7 per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid.

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place, and the holder should place, the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses, including 10 per cent of the indebtedness as attorney's fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said W.D. Parrish and P.C. Gower

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, and State aforesaid, on the North side of Oscar Street, between Mayberry Street and an alley running parallel with Westfield Street and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the northwest corner of an alley and Oscar Street, and running thence with Oscar Street approximately N. 71-3/4 W. 300 feet to iron pin on Oscar Street; thence approximately N. 18-1/2 E. 172.5 feet to an iron pin; thence approximately S. 67-1/2 E. 300 feet to iron pin on alley; thence with said alley approximately S. 18-1/2 W. 150 feet to the beginning. Being known as lots Nos. 9, 10 and 11 of Westfield lands and being the same land conveyed to us by T.C. Gower by deed dated.

Also all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Ward three of the City of Greenville, in the County and State aforesaid, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pipe at the northwest corner of Hudson and Oscar Streets and running thence N. 23-45 E. 136.5 feet to an iron pipe; thence S. 58-0 E. 132 feet to a stake; thence S. 65-0 E. 124.5 feet to an iron pipe at the corner of a 17 foot alley; thence with line of said alley S. 20-57 W. 166.7 feet to an iron pipe at the corner of said alley and Oscar Street; thence with Oscar Street N. 55-12 W. 263 feet to an iron pipe the beginning corner. Being lot No. 5, as shown on revised plat of property of Parrish & Gower by R.E. Dalton, Engineer, dated August 1919, and recorded in plat book E., page 143.

Also all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land on the south side of Oscar Street: Beginning at a point on Oscar Street 54 feet West of the corner of Mayfield and Oscar Streets and running thence with Oscar Street N. 54-52 W. 120.5 feet to an iron pipe; thence S. 23-30 W. 93.8 feet to an iron pipe; thence S. 54 E. 22 feet to the corner of an alley; thence N. 35-08 E. 8 feet to rear corner of lot No. 3; thence S. 54-0 E. with line of an 8 foot alley 79 feet to rear corner of lots Nos. 1 and 2, thence N. 35-08 E. 90.1 feet to an iron pin on Oscar Street the beginning corner. Being lots Nos. 2, 3 and 4 as shown on revised plat of property of Parrish & Gower by R.E. Dalton, Engineer, dated August 1919, and recorded in plat book E., page 143.

The last two parcels of land being the same conveyed to us by Parrish and Gower by deed dated. This mortgage being given to secure a portion of the purchase price of the within described property.
