in the full and sum of \$25,000.00, well and truly indebted to B. E. Geer, my attorney, for his services in connection with the sale of my property, (L. S.)

Dollars, to be paid on the 1st day of January, 1920, and thereafter annually, until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place, and the holder should place, the said note, or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses, including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness for attorney's fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said B. E. Geer, Trustee, All those certain pieces, parcels or lots of land situate, lying and being in the city of Greenville, County and state aforesaid on or near the west side of South Main Street, and being the lots of land conveyed to me as follows:

- (1) From Acme Loom, Harness and Reed Co., by deed dated May 20, 1920 and recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 53, page 404.
- (2) Lot conveyed to me by G. W. Symmes et al., by deed dated Sept 3, 1919 and recorded in Vol. 58 page 29 R. M. C. Office, which lot has a frontage on S. Main St. of 43.30 ft. more or less.
- (3) Lot of land measuring 24 ft. on S. Main St, with depth of 31 ft lying north of lot # 8 as shown on plat recorded in Plat Book C, page 49, conveyed to me by Greenville Trust Co by deed dated Aug 12, 1918 and recorded in Vol 25, Page 259.
- (4) Lot known as no. 8 on plat recorded in Plat Book C, page 49, having a frontage of 19.9 ft. on S. Main St and running back to a depth of 31.5 ft. more or less conveyed to me by Greenville Trust Co by deed dated May 9, 1913 and recorded in Vol. 25, Page 326.
- (5) Also all that piece, parcel or lot of land situate on the west side of S. Main St. in the city of Greenville and bounded on the southwest by lots (1) and (3) as described above, owned by me, and by lots owned or held by J. W. Norwood, and bounded on the northeast by lot owned by me described as (2) above, which lot has a frontage on the west side of S. Main St. of 20 ft. more or less, and running back to a depth of 9.8 ft. more or less, with a width in the back of 20 ft. more or less. This lot being an old unnamed abandoned street and is the property of the mortgagor, the owner of the property on both sides of same. This lot is subject to a certain side track easement.
- (6) Lot (4) as shown above being subject to a first mortgage of Five Thousand (\$5000.00) Dollars to Mrs. F. R. - (7) Also all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in the city of Greenville, lying on the west side of an alley which alley runs in a northerly direction from University St parallel with Augusta Street at a distance of approximately 160 ft in an easterly direction from Augusta Street, which lot is more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin corner of lots 5 and 6 on said alley, thence with said alley n. 38° E 60 ft to stake on said alley, corner of lots 3 and 4, n. 47° 34' W. 57 ft. to stake rear corner of lot sold to B. E. Geer; thence with line of lot no 6, S. 40° 12' W. 50 ft. to stake on line of lot no 6; thence with line of lot no 6 S. 47° 34' E. 60 feet to the beginning corner on said alley.
