computed and paid

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue  
thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of 10% of above amount

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to  
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,  
be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said G. W. Williams

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to L. E. Barstrell, the said L. E. Barstrell

in hand well and truly paid by the said G. W. Williams

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,  
bargain, sell and release unto the said G. W. Williams his heirs and assigns, the

following tract of land, All that certain tract or parcel of  
land situated in Cleveland Township, County of Greenville  
on Middle Saluda River, known as part of Drake place,  
containing one hundred twenty-five acres more or less,  
bounded by lands of L. S. Drake, John Harris, and  
L. D. Potts land having the following courses and distances:

Beginning on a rock in Drake and L. D. Potts  
line, running N. 35 E. 5.30 to a Spanish oak in hollow,  
thence N. 12 E. 6.12 to poplar in branch above house, thence  
N. 24 E. 5.00 to hickory at spring near house, thence N. 5  
W. with said spring branch 9.50 ch. to rock on Jones Gap  
road on south bank of Middle Saluda River, thence  
with said road and river, thence across said River  
(West of and near mouth of Rabbit branch) N. 21 W. with
