bargain, sell and release unto the said Mrs Victoria Euca

Her, heirs and assigns; also, that certain piece, parcel or lot  
of land, situated, lying and being in the State of  
South Carolina, and County and Township of Greenville,  
on Monroe Street and near Hampton Avenue Extension, hav-  
ing the following metes and bounds to wit; Beginning  
at a stake on the west side of Monroe Street, 110 feet  
and 6 inches from the north side of Hampton Avenue  
Extension, and running thence N. 29° 26' 76" feet to a stake  
thence N. 45° E. 70 feet to a stake; thence S. 39° E. 50 feet to  
a stake on said Monroe Street; thence with said Monroe  
Street S. 31° 26' 66" feet and 6 inches to the beginning corner.  
This being the same lot of land conveyed to Frank Ferguson  
by R. L. Jones, by deed dated January 17th, 1920, and recorded  
in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Book 66, page 221.

at a stake on said road 80 feet from the northwest cor-  
ner of said road and Monroe Street, thence with said road  
N. 39° 26' 60 feet to a stake; thence 7° 51' 15" feet to a  
stake thence S. 34° E. 32 feet to a stake; thence S. 45° 26' 70  
feet to a stake; thence S. 59° E. 20 feet to a stake; thence  
S. 47° 26' 90 feet to the beginning corner.
