SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, we the said Annie Lee Greene, William A. Greene, Floride
Greene and Luther L. Greene
in and by our certain promissory note in writing, of
even date with these presents, are well and truly indebted to

in the full and just sum of Forty-seven hundred and ninety-two
Dollars, to be paid on or before one year after date at Greenville S.C.

with interest thereon from date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue
thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
