SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said R. M. Hollingsworth  
in and by a certain Trustee note in writing, of  
even date with these presents, and well and truly indebted to

N. M. Cannon  
in the full and just sum of Seventy-Eight & 67/100  
Dollars, to be paid Or on before Dec. 10th 1921

with interest thereon from date at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid annually

until paid in full, all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue  
thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

Five per cent besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to  
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,  
be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being  
thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I the said R. M. Hollingsworth  
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

N. M. Cannon  
according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me the said  
R. M. Hollingsworth  
in hand well and truly paid by the said N. M. Cannon

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,  
bargain, sell and release unto the said N. M. Cannon

All that certain piece parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being  
in the state and County aforesaid near the town of Greer  
and having the following metes and bounds to-wit: Beginning  
at an iron pin on James Street and running almost north  
with R. M. Hollingsworth's line 152 1/2 feet more or less to an  
iron pin, thence east 10 feet to an iron pin thence almost  
south 153 feet more or less to iron pin on James Street,  
thence west 10 feet to the beginning corner.
