thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten (10%) percent
besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to

be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being

County, State of South Carolina, in the town of Fountain Inn,
commencing on the corner of Main and Hellams streets
and running thence N. 52 E. 150 feet to alley, thence along
said alley S. 38 E. 66 2/3 feet to an iron pin, thence S. 52 N. 150
feet to corner on main street, thence N. 38 W. to the beginning
corner and bounded by Main and Hellams streets, alley
and land of J. W. Fowler, being known and designated as
Lots nos. 4 and 5, in the general plan of the town of
Fountain Inn according to the survey of the town made
by J. R. Hellams in 1886 and being the same lots of land
