SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, we, the said Wm. H. Whittle, E. E. Stone and Lena W. Stone in and by 600 certain 1700 note in writing, of even date with these presents,

in the full and just sum of Thirty-five hundred dollars to be paid on account

with interest thereon from date at the rate of 5 per cent. per annum to be computed and paid.

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note..... to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

10 percent of the amount due..... besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note....., to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note....., reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

according to the terms of the said note....., and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to date, the said

in hand well and truly paid by the said H. C. Shirley

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

H. C. Shirley

(The said estate being part or lot of land situated, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, fronting on White Street and adjoining lots of William Wood, Mrs. Anne Pittman and Mr. C. Davis, and having the following width and lines, to-wit:

Beginning at a post in the middle side of White Street at road corner; running Eastward from said corner of White and Pittman Streets until Wood's lines (forty-five), thence you go to a stake in Mrs. Anne Pittman's lines, thence southwardly Pittman's line Eastward forty-five feet to a stake, corner of the road or street corner of Pittman's line, thence with said line to the road corner of Pittman's line and you go to a stake in White Street, thence Wood's road and Pittman's line forty-five feet to the beginning corner and being the same lot contained in the survey of H. C. Shirley.
