until paid in full, all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note..... to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue
thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of.....

One Hundred dollars..... besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note....., to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,
be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note....., reference being
thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That..... the said 1114
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said 1114

according to the terms of the said note....., and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to 1114, the said 1114

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,
1114 and his heirs and assigns

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate lying and being in the
State of South Carolina and county and Township of Greenville,
near Greenville, on the Parker Road, and being known as Lot
#11, in the Subdivision of land known as Hixonglan
Linen Mill, and is recorded in the R.M.C.C. L. #1, in said County and
State in Book No. 1, C. 1, page 63, said lot having a frontage of
50 feet on Parker Road, and a depth on the Hixonglan Creek of 140 feet
and on the Hixonglan Creek 18.9 feet, and being 50 feet wide in the rear.
This being the same lot of land contained in lot #11, Parker
Road, according even date with said present instrument and not yet
recorded. This mortgage is given to secure the balance of the purchase
money for the lot of land hereinabove named.

All that tract, lot, piece or parcel of land, situated lying and
being in the same locality and adjoining the same described lot
of land, used to know as lot #11, in the same manner
lot, having a frontage of 50 feet on Parker Road and a depth of
approximately 14 feet, being 50 feet wide in the rear, this being
the same lot conveyed to me by Errol C. Baldwin by deed dated
15th day of Oct. 1919 and recorded in the R.M.C.C. office for a
sum of \$100.00 in lot #11, C. 1, page 128, to which
reference is made.
