until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue

and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of 10 per cent.

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said J. S. Mauldin

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Parker Land Company,

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said

in hand well and truly paid by the said Parker Land Company

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Parker Land Company, tract of land described below

purchased by me this day from Parker Land Company, and for which the above mentioned promissory note is given in part payment.

That certain lot or parcels of land situate in Greenville, Greenville County, designated as tract nos. 71, 72, 75, 81, 85 and 90 on plat #2 property of Parker Land Company surveyed by A. S. Bedell, April 1914 with subsequent changes and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point under the hedge in the centre of the Parker road and in the centre of the Poorhouse, a corner of tracts nos. 68, 71, and 54 runs thence with the centre of the Poorhouse branch and the line of tract nos. 64 m. 86 E. 262.7 ft. to a point in the centre of said branch and the line of tract no. 64, thence m. 72 1/2 E. 75 ft. to a point in the centre of said branch, thence still with the line of tract no. 64 S. 49.15 E. 42.3 ft. to an iron pie a corner of tract no. 64 thence S. 82-13 E. 177.3 ft. (the old Hallard and Johnson line) to a corner, thence still with the line of the Hallard and Johnson tract n. 25-326.737.0 ft. to a corner in the fork of the East Poor House branch and Langton branch, the southwest corner of tract no. 76, thence with the center of the East Poorhouse branch and the western boundary of tract no. 76, 814 ft. to a point in the centre of the Davidson Road, thence with the centre of Davidson road and the lines of tracts nos. 76 and 86, the following courses and distances: m. 25-30 E. 210 ft. m. 32-30 E. 202 ft. m. 11-30 S. 350 ft. m. 13 E. 173 ft. to a stake, the corner of tracts nos. 86 and 91, thence stee with the centre of Davidson Road and the line of tract no. 91, m. 35-30 E. 90 ft. 91.68-10-E. 40-0 ft. to where the road forks the corner of tracts nos. 100 and 97, thence with the line of tract no. 97 m. 64-45 W. 684.42 ft. to the middle of the east Poor House Branch, at a point opposite three maples on its west bank in the line of tract 710-89, thence following the centre of said branch back to a point in the centre of said branch, in the line of tract no. 86, thence with the line of tract nos. 89 m. 76-3-W. 366 ft. to a point in the centre of the new Poor House road in the line of tract no. 84 and the southwest corner of tract no. 89, thence following the centre of the new Poor House road and the line of tract no. 84 360 ft. to a point the corner of tracts nos. 84, 85, 80 and 81, thence with the centre of the said road and the line of tract no. 80 1210 ft. to a point at the intersection of the new Poor House road and the Parker Road, the corner of five tracts nos. 77, 79, 80, 75 and 76.
