Dollars, to be paid One year from date

with interest thereon from the day of Sept 1920 at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid annually

until paid in full, all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal, and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue  
thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of Ten Per Cent

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to  
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,  
be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being  
thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said C. E. Smith  
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said  
M. O. Glenn

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said  
C. E. Smith  
in hand well and truly paid by the said M. O. Glenn

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,  
bargain, sell and release unto the said M. O. Glenn

All that certain piece parcel or lot of land  
situated lying and being in Greenville County  
and State aforesaid, and in the town of  
Greer, on Cannon Street, and having the following  
metes and bounds to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on Cannon Street  
on D. M. Wood corner and running thence S. 7.15  
W. 195.5 feet to iron pin, thence South 84 E. 66  
feet, to iron pin, thence North 7.15 E. 193.5 feet  
to iron pin on Cannon Street, thence with  
Cannon Street N. 82-45 W. 66 feet to beginning  
corner. Bounded on North by Cannon Street,  
on East by D. M. Wood, on South by Cannon  
lots, and on West by D. M. Wood. Being the
