interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note..... to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue
thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of.....

Att. fee will be collected besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note....., to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,
be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note....., reference being
thereto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That..... the said J. C. Williams

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said J. C. Wakefield

according to the terms of the said note....., and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said J. C. Williams

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,
bargain, sell and release unto the said J. C. Wakefield, his heirs and assigns, forever,

all that certain piece parcel or tract of land containing thirty-one
and one-half (31 1/2) acres, more or less, situated lying and being in
Greenville Township, State, and County aforesaid, lying between the Brewerille
road and Sabalda River, about one mile North of Hickman S.C. and
having the following metes:

Beginning at a stone &c on the Brewerille road, thence
N. 66° W. 10'-10 to stone &c thence S. 58' 2" W. 11'-40 to a pine &c, S. 46'-77 W.
7'-50 to mouth of branch on Sabalda River. Thence down the
maine of said river 14'-00 to stake &c, thence N. 86 E. 13'-50 to corner
of aforesaid road, thence with said road to the beginning point, and
is known as lot no. 7 in the division of the lands of the estate
of Reuben Beam, deceased, and being the same tract of land conveyed to me
