this 30th day of June 1922

with me hereon from A. W. Courry at the rate of Six per cent. per annum to be

computed and paid annually

without interest until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or

interest be at any time due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue

thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent on amount

paid besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to

the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,

be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being

thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I the said S. J. Casey

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said A. W. Courry

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me the said S. J. Casey

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,

bargain, sell and release unto the said A. W. Courry
