bargain, sell and release unto the said Mrs. Ida May Tumblin, her heirs and assigns forever, All

State and County aforesaid, containing fifty acres, more or less, and being that same
tract of land conveyed to me by W.A. McKelvey by his deed bearing date of Nov. 27th,
