interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue
thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten dollars, besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,
be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being
thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,
bargain, sell and release unto the said

J. L. Cox, his heirs and assigns, all those two
certain pieces, parcels, and tracts of land situate,
lying and being in Fairview Township County and
State aforesaid, bounded by lands of John Chiles
W. M. Cox, H. M. Moore and others, and containing
24.81 acres and 12.25 acres respectively, more
or less and being the same two tracts conveyed
this day to me by the said J. L. Cox (not yet record-
ed). Also same conveyed to said J. L. Cox (1st tract
by H. M. Moore by deed dated Jan. 7 1918 and recorded
in Office of P. M. C. for the County in Vol. 41 at
page 610, (2nd tract) by myself by deed dated Dec.
31, 1918 and recorded in said office in Vol.
57 at page 16.
