WHEREAS, I, H.C. Hunt, the said H.C. Hunt

in the full and just sum of Six hundred (\$500.00)

Dollars, to be paid one year after date

with interest thereon from date By D.L. Potts at the rate of eight per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid annually Witness: D.L. Potts

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue
thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten per cent of amount due besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,
be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being
thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, H.C. Hunt, the said H.C. Hunt
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,
bargain, sell and release unto the said H.C. Hunt, all those pieces, parcels or lots of land in Cleveland

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing Eighteen (18) acres,
more or less, and five (5) acres, more or less, respectively.
The same as was conveyed to D.L. Potts by M.M. Tankersley by deed dated Jan. 16, 1920,
and recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 55, page 174 and being the
same two pieces of land this day conveyed to me by D.L. Potts, this mortgage being given
to secure balance of purchase money.
