all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in Cleveland

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

Situate lying and being about eighteen miles north of the city  
 of Greenville, and near Cleveland, between on the Jones Gap road  
 and the Cleveland Head road and on waters of Middle Saluda  
 River having the following metes and bounds to wit:

Beginning at the mouth of Dan W. Jenkins branch on  
 Middle Fork of Saluda River, thence up said branch and up  
 its meanderings and Mrs. Garrett D. Wilkies line to the Cedar  
 Head road (41 inches), thence west course with said road 13-  
 chains to a stake on said road, thence N. 13° W. 13.50 to a stone
