all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in Greenville

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

All that certain piece, parcel and lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, and being more particularly described on a plat made by Carter & Pringle, Surveyors, which plat is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for said County and State as Lot No. 1 of Block "C" fronting 50 feet on Melrose Avenue of the lands of the Melrose Land Company, a Corporation, and being known as Lot No. 1 of the property called "Melrose".

Also, All that other certain piece, parcel and lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, and being more particularly described on a plat made by Carter & Pringle Surveyors, which Plat is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for said County and State, as Lot No. 2 of Block C, fronting 50 feet on Melrose Avenue of the lands of the Melrose Land Company, a Corporation, and being known as Lot No. 2 of the property called "Melrose".
