in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof according to the terms of the said note and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me in hand well and truly paid and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said H. N. Lawrence, Attorney

all that piece, parcel, part and of land situated in Greenville

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

Known as lot more two and three, Block "C" of the Sterling Annex, said sterling annex being located just beyond the limits of the city of Greenville, South of Jenkins Street and adjoining the property commonly known as Sterling College. A plat of said Sterling Annex is recorded in "D" (page 49) and transferred to "B" (page 81) of reference to said plat the dimensions of lots two and three of block "C" will be found as follows:

Beginning on the north side of Valentine Street eighty-eight and 5/10 (88.5') feet from May Street, thence N. 23-42 E. 100 feet to an iron pile, thence with line of lot no. 4 N. 53-45 E. 156.25 feet to an iron pin, thence S. 24-05 E. 100 feet, thence S. 53-45 W. 156.8 feet to the beginning corner being the same lots conveyed to me by Thomas P. Parker by deed dated October 8th, 1914 and recorded in Vol. 27, Page 409 R.R.C. office for Greenville County.

Also: All that certain lot in Greenville Township, County and state aforesaid near the corporate limits of the city of Greenville being lot no. 1 of Block C represented by plat of Sterling Annex, plat recorded in Plat Book "C" page 80, beginning at Northwest corner of Valentine and May Streets, thence along May Street N. 48-25 E. 164.7 feet to corner lot 10, thence S. 24-15 W. 47 feet to corner of lot no. 2, thence S. 64-44 W. 156.8 feet to Valentine Street thence with Valentine Street S. 23-42 E. 88.3 feet to the beginning corner, being same lot conveyed to me by Maria C. Davis and recorded in Volume 45 Page 1495, R.R.C. office for Greenville County and dated July 21st, 1919.
