all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in Bates Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

Known as part of the lands conveyed to W. E. Hart by deed from G. W. Bishop, adjoining lands of James Kelley, Charley Poole and others. Beginning on a poplar stump, thence running S. 41 E. 10.5 chs. to a stone in old road; thence with said road N. 9 E. 17.76 chs. to a W. O. X 30 m.; thence S. 76 3/4 W. 10.15 to a hickory 3 x 0 m.; thence N. 13 1/4 E. 6.60 chs. to the beginning corner and contains 10 acres, the same more or less, being the same conveyed to me by W. E. Hart by deed dated January 13, 1920 recorded in Book 45, page 50.
