all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in.....
Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,.....

About three miles northeast of the city of Greenville just south of the National Highway on the east side of Summit Drive and described as follows to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin on the east side of Summit Drive corner of lot no 1 of a plat of Croft-Stone Acres and property belonging to J. D. Bridges (known as Woodale Farm) and running thence along line of lot B0 1 S. 30.18 E. 681.7 feet to a stone; thence along line of lot no. 6 of said Croft-Stone Acres S. 56-0 E. 33.7 feet to an iron pipe on line of Croft-Stone Acres; thence N. 23.22 W. 751 feet to an iron pin on the east side of Summit Drive; thence along the east side of Summit Drive S. 43.0 W. 110 feet to the beginning corner and containing one acre more or less according to a survey made by R. E. Dalton Sept. 1921. Being the same lot conveyed to me by E. E. Stone and P. C. Stone by deed dated October 5, 1921 and recorded in vol 74, page 105
There is situated on said lot a six room dwelling house.
