promised and agreed to pay ten per cent of the whole amount due for attorney's fees, if said note be collected by an attorney or through legal proceedings of any kind, reference being hereunto had with more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said John R. McDonald

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me

in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Gatti-Goodyear Company

all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the Fifth Ward of the City of Greenville, on the North

side of Verdry Street, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on Verdry Street, corner of P.H. Hajar property and running thence N. 15-48 W. 30.7 feet to an iron pin on R. Leonardt's property; thence S. 70-55 W. 40.5 feet to iron pin; thence S. 15-48 E. 191.5 feet to iron pin on Verdry Street; thence along Verdry Street S. 71-24 E. 64.5 feet to the beginning corner, as per plat recorded in Plat Book C., at page 269; this being the same lot of land conveyed to me by Gatti-Goodyear Company by deed dated this day and not yet recorded.
