all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

Lying and being on Perry Avenue in Ward Five of the City of Greenville, and having the following lines and bounds to it, according to a plat made by J. G. Serrill, commencing at an iron post on Perry Avenue corner of lot now or formerly owned by Miss Anita Thurston and running thence with her line \$18.00 N. 14 $\frac{1}{2}$  feet to a fence; thence with a line parallel with Perry Avenue \$1.72.00 N. 60 feet to a corner on land of Mrs. Addie R. Angel; thence with her line N. 18.00 E. 14 $\frac{1}{2}$  feet to an iron post on Perry Avenue; thence with Perry Avenue \$1.72.00 E. 60 feet to the beginning corner.
