NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said Sam Rossland
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better
securing the payment thereof according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me

in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and
released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Bank of America

all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in Baggot
Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

containing 32 acres, more or less, conveyed to me by
Levin M. Parker and Grace H. Harrison by deed dated
January 30, 1898, recorded in Book W. N. W. page 148.
Also that tract of land adjoining the land above described
containing 29 acres, conveyed to me by Julia D. Charles.
