WHEREAS I, J. H. Wilbanks,

am well and truly indebted to N. H. Harris  
in the full and just sum of Two Hundred Ninety Three 13/100

Dollars, in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date herewith, due and payable on the 1st

day of July, 1922.

at the rate of eight per cent per annum until paid; interest to be computed and paid annually  
and if unpaid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal until paid, and I have further  
promised and agreed to pay ten per cent. of the whole amount due for attorney's fees, if said note be collected by an attorney or through legal proceedings of any kind, reference being hereto had and more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, J. H. Wilbanks, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said N. H. Harris,

all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in Greenville,

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

About 3 1/2 miles west of Greenville Court House near the Easley Bridge Road, having as a portion of lot no. 5 on file, Block 77 of Highland sub division recorded in Plat Book "A" page 208, and having the following mites and bounds: Beginning at a stake on Easley Bridge Road which stake is 60 feet from the intersection of Easley Bridge Road and Florida Avenue and running thence with Easley Bridge Roads 8 7/16 20 feet to stake corner of lot no 4 thence with line of lot no 4 in a southerly direction 200.49 feet to stake in line of lot no 6 thence with line of lot no. 6 in a westerly direction 20 feet to stake and thence in a northerly direction 200 feet, more or less, to the beginning corner.

Also that other lot of land in the Township County and state aforesaid about 2 1/2 miles west of Greenville Court house near the Easley Bridge road, known as lot no. 5 on part of Block 77 of Highland sub division recorded in Plat Book "E" page 208 and having the following mites and bounds: Beginning at an iron pin on east side of Florida Avenue, corner of lot no. 5, which pin is 200 feet from the Easley Bridge road, thence with Florida Avenue S. 22° 10' 80" feet to line of lot no. 8, thence with line of lot no. 8 in an easterly direction 168.87 feet to stake, joint corner of lots nos. 6, 7, 8 and 9, thence in a northwesterly direction with line of lot no. 7, 80 feet to stake in line of lot no. 3, thence in a westerly direction with line of lots nos. 3, 4 and 5, 177.77 feet to the beginning corner.

This mortgage is given to secure a portion of the purchase price of the above described lots of land.
