Nealall that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in Greenville

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the east side of Mulberry Street in the City of Greenville having the following notes and bounds: Beginning at a point on the East side of Mulberry Street 150 feet from Buncombe Street, and running thence in a southeasterly direction parallel with Buncombe Street 106 feet to a stake; thence in a southeasterly direction in a line parallel with Mulberry Street 60 feet to a stake; thence in a northwesterly direction in a line parallel with Buncombe Street 106 feet to a stake on Mulberry Street; thence in a northwesterly direction with Mulberry Street 60 feet to the beginning corner.
