all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in *Greenville*

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

All my right, title and interest in and to all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the City and County of Greenville, State of aforesaid, on *Gadsden Street, 9 1/2 feet wide*, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at the corner of the lot owned by *Francis M. Bailey* on *Gadsden Street* and running thence with said street *9 1/2 x 8.70* feet to an iron fence, corner of lot formerly owned by *Anna M. Richey*, now owned by *Isa C. Green*, thence with *Isa C. Green's* line *8.27 1/2 x 140* feet to line of *J. M. M. Gee*, lot, thence with line of *J. M. M. Gee* *9 1/2 x 24.70* feet to *E. T. Bateman's* line; thence with *Bateman's* line *N. 22 1/2 x 8.140* feet to the beginning corner, being the same lot of land conveyed to *A. A. Phillips* by *J. K. Martin*, his deed dated April 12, 1913, recorded in *R. M. C. Office for Greenville County*, Vol. 18, page 141. The interest herein conveyed being the interest acquired by me, heir at law of my wife, *Pearl Green* who died intestate and who was *executor* of the said *A. A.
