all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in Greenville,
 Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, In the city of Greenville, and being
 known and designated as lot No 43 of Block 2 in East
 Park, part of Boyce Addition to Greenville, South
 Carolina, according to a plat thereof now recorded
 in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat
 Book A, page 305, and having the following metes
 and bounds; Beginning at an iron pin on the
 Washington Road, corner of lots Nos. 42 and 43, and
 running thence S. 17-38 E. 175 feet to an iron pin
 on Boyce Spring Avenue, thence in a northeasterly
 direction, along Boyce Spring Avenue, 50 feet to corner
 of lots Nos. 43 and 44 thence N. 17-30 W. 175 feet to
 an iron pin on the Washington Road; thence
