in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Alfred E. Miller

all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing 29 acres, more or less, located on east side of

the Enoree River and bounded by lands of G.W. Leece, J.J. Black, Thad Samons and the estate of Henry Greer, deceased, being a part of a tract of land conveyed to A.H. Budwell by D.P. Verner, Master by deed dated April 28, 1894 and conveyed to J.Center by said A.H. Bridwell by deed dated Jan. 8, 1919, recorded in office of R.I.C. for Greenville County in Book 44, page 372, and conveyed by J.Center to John A. Russell by deed dated June 23, 1922, recorded in Book 74, page 555.
