DOLLARS, eight per cent. per annum until the 1<sup>st</sup> series of shares of the capital stock of said Association shall have a value of one hundred dollars per share as ascertained under the By-Laws of said Association, and shall then repay to said Association the sum of Twelve Hundred & no/100

It is further stipulated and agreed, that any sums expended by said Association for insurance of the property or for payment of taxes thereon, or for redemption or encumbrance, shall be added to and constitute a part of the debt hereby secured, and shall bear interest at same rate.

It is agreed by and between the said parties that the said mortgagee shall not be liable for any loss or damage to the said premises until default shall be made.
