I, Franklin Smith

SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said Franklin Smith

in and by Greenville Building and Loan Association, a corporation, incorporated under the laws of the State of South Carolina, in well and truly indebted to GREENVILLE BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, a corporation, incorporated under the laws of the State of South Carolina, in the full and just sum of Four thousand (\$4,000.00) DOLLARS,

to be paid on or before the date when the Series of the Capital Stock of the said GREENVILLE BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION shall reach maturity, with interest thereon from date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum, payable weekly on or before Saturday night of each and every week until paid in full; and if I fail to pay said interest or to comply in all respects with the Constitution and By-Laws of the Association, for the space of thirty days, then said debt shall become immediately due and payable, together with all interest and expenses, and all amounts advanced by the said Association on the within described property by way of taxes or insurance, the same to be added to the amount due on said note and to be collectible as part thereof together with an attorney's fee of ten per cent. if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection of said debt or any part thereof he collected by an attorney, or legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the reference being hereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said Franklin Smith

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said GREENVILLE BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of three Dollars, to me

in hand well and truly paid by the said GREENVILLE BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION at and before the signing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have Granted, Bargained, Sold, and Released unto the said GREENVILLE BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION Franklin Smith

All that piece of land, situate, lying, and being in the City of Greenville, S.C. and in subdivision known as Overbrook, and is known and designated as Lot No. 43, according to plat made by Oliver Jones September 17, 1913, and has the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the north side of Overbrook Drive, being the joint corner of Lot Nos 43 and 44, and running thence with said Drive, N. 72-27 E. 100 feet to iron pin, corner of Lot Nos. 44 and 45; thence with line of Lot no 45 N. 10-35 W. 252.3 feet to iron pin on an alley; thence with said Alley S. 75-24 W. 56.4 feet to iron pin on said alley; thence with line of Lot No. 43 S. 1.13 E. 264.3 feet to the beginning corner.
