WITNESSETH, Whereas, the said party of the first part is indebted to said MECHANICS PERPETUAL BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION in the sum of Six Thousand

per cent. per annum, payable weekly, the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure:

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

*All that lot of land situate on the west side of Poy street in the City and County of Greenville South Carolina beginning at an iron pin on Poy street at the intersection of a 15 foot alley and run thence S. 65 W. along the line of said alley 101 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 15 E. 60 feet more or less, to the corner of the lot now owned and occupied by Caroline H. E. Baugh; thence N. 65 E. 101 feet to an iron pin on Poy street; thence with Poy street 60 feet, more or less, to the beginning corner being the same land conveyed to me as two lots by Walter S. Skiffin, by deed dated the 31st. day of March 1922 and recorded in Volume 73 page 554.*
