WITNESSETH, Whereas the said party of the first part is indebted to said MECHANICS PERPETUAL BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION in the sum of Twenty five hundred 20/100

25 Dollars, money loaned this day, with interest thereon from this date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum, payable weekly,

the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure:

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

In the city of Greenville, being a portion of the Rowley Place and having the following metes and bounds to-wit: Commencing at an iron stake, northeast corner of Lavinia Avenue and a ten foot alley; thence in an easterly direction along said alley 14.5 feet to a stake; thence in a northerly direction to a stake on a 10 foot alley; thence along said alley 4.3 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of lots Nos. 24 and 25; thence in a southwesterly direction along joint line of said lots 15.5 feet to an iron pin on Lavinia Avenue; thence 22.45 E. along said Avenue 5.5 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner, being known as lot no. 24 in survey of said Rowley Place by W. A. Adams January, 1910, being the same conveyed to Olga Young Henry by deed dated February 2, 1920, recorded in Book 69, page 14.
