SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, St. L. Dawes, the said St. L. Dawes

in and by my certain promissory note in 1937 writing, of even date with
these presents are well and truly indebted to Ben C. Thonitau

in the full and just sum of One Hundred Fifty-two and 50/100 (152.50) Dollars
to be paid: on or before July 1, 1936

Paid in full 18th Dec

with interest thereon from date at the rate of seven
per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid at maturity
until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due
and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose
this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of 10% of the amount due

to be added to the amount due on said note and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said
debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under the mortgage); as in and by the said
note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That the said Mortgagee, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the
payment thereof to the said Mortgagee, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to the said
Mortgagee in hand well and truly paid by the said Mortgagee, at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,
have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain and release unto the said Mortgagee, and his

Heirs and Assigns, forever, all and singular that contain, piece, parcel, lot or tract of land situate, lying and being in
Spaulville Township, Greenville County, State aforesaid,

on the south side of West Augusta Drive, near
the City of Greenville, being all of Lot #92 and
a portion of lot no. 91 as shown on plat of prop-
erty of Melville C. Westcott, Trustee, known
as "Augusta Circle", made by R. E. Dalton Engineer
November, 1921, recorded in Plat Book "4" at
page 23, being bounded on the North by West
Augusta Drive, on the East by the remaining
portion of lot no. 91 now or formerly owned
by Helen M. Cullough Smith and the south by
lot no. 94 now or formerly owned by A. B. Smith
son, and by lot no. 95 now or formerly
owned by W. Alston, and having the follow-
ing metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the South
side of West Augusta Drive, corner of Lot No. 93, and
running thence with the line of said lot S. 21-35-
N. 146.8 feet to an iron pin in line of lot No. 94;
thence with the line of said lot, S. 71-35-E. 48.76
feet to the rec corner of lot no. 94; thence
with the rec line of said lot S. 21-52 N. 50 feet
to an iron pin in line of lot no. 95; thence
with the line of said lot, S. 71-35-E. 13.76 feet to
an iron pin in line of lot No. 95; thence N.
21-52 E. 178.5 feet to an iron pin on West
Augusta Drive; thence with the South side
of West Augusta Drive, N. 55-15-N. 65 feet to the
beginning corner; said premises being
that conveyed to St. L. Dawes, by St. J. Danigel
by deed dated December 7, 1923, and recorded
in the W. D. 11 for Greenville County
in Book of Deeds "91" at page 164.
