

MAJOR LATERAL PIPELINES**Texas Laterals****La Gloria Lateral Loop**

One 12-inch transmission purchase lateral loop (Line "B"), approximately 3.49 miles in length, beginning at approximate mile post 78.90 on main line "A", located in the Ramon De La Garza—El Paisano Survey, A-170, and continuing in a westerly direction to outlet header at the South Texas—Falfurrias M&R Station, located in the Ignacio De La Pena Los Olmos Y Loma Blanca Survey, A-345, all in Jim Wells County, Texas. Included in this lateral loop are a tap valve and check valve assembly and a lateral valve at the beginning of the lateral, a valve and scraper trap assembly at the beginning of the lateral, a valve and scraper trap assembly, a valve and cross-over to the 16-inch header, a valve and cross-over to the 16-inch header from the existing 10-inch lateral, at the end of the transmission purchase lateral.

Offshore Texas**Blk. 10L to Blk. 52L**

One 16-inch transmission purchase lateral, approximately 12.20 miles in length, beginning at the riser of Mobil Oil platform A-1 in Blk. 10L, High Island, and continuing in a southwesterly direction to the riser at Standard of Texas Platform in Block 52L, High Island, Offshore, Jefferson County, Texas.

Louisiana Laterals**Southwest Louisiana Gathering System
Southwest Louisiana Gathering Lateral Loop**

One 30-inch Southwest Louisiana Gathering Lateral (Loop "B"), approximately 20.59 miles in length, beginning on the north bank of the Intracoastal Canal, located in Section 35, T-11-S, R-13-W, Calcasieu Parish, and continuing in a southerly direction to the end of the loop section in Mobil Oil Company's Cameron Gas Processing Plant located in Section 23, T-15-S, R-13-W, Cameron Parish, all in the state of Louisiana. Included in this lateral is a lateral valve with scraper trap and tie-over to the existing line on the north bank of the Intracoastal Canal, a lateral valve with tie-over to the existing line on the south bank of the Intracoastal Canal, a 6-inch tap valve assembly at M.P. 5.20 for the Pan Am—South Black Bayou Lateral, and a lateral valve with scraper trap and tie-over to the existing line at the end of this loop section.
