The following described piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying
and being in the County of greenville and State of South Carolina
known and designated as Tract No. Four, according to a certain map
or plat of the J. M. Kilgore place made by R. C. Dalton, Engr. in
September 1919, which plat is of record in the office of the R. M. C.
for greenville County in Plat Book C. at page 189, reference to
which is made as a part of this description, the said piece, parcel
or lot of land being described by metes and bounds, as follows:
Beginning at a point on the Western line of the Simpsonville
Road, where said road crosses Gilders Creek and running thence
north 7 degrees 40 min East, along the western line of said
Simpsonville Road, seventy-five feet, more or less to a point
thence north 58 degrees East Three Hundred Thirty three feet to
a point; thence continuing with said road north 63 degrees 10 min
East Five Hundred feet to a point; thence north 62 degrees East,
and continuing with said road Eleven Hundred feet to a point,
the same being the intersection of the said Simpsonville Road
with the greenville-Woodruff Road; thence north 39 degrees 9 min
West, along the greenville-Woodruff Road Two Hundred Twenty-nine
feet to a point, being the intersection of the southern line of Pelgrim
Church lot with said Road; thence south 81 degrees West, along said
southern line of the Pelgrim Church Lot, One thousand Forty feet
to a point; thence north 20 degrees 20 min. West Two Hundred
Fifty-one feet to a point; thence south 46 degrees 15 min. West
Fourteen Hundred six feet to a Water Oak on the northern line
of Gilders Creek, thence along the meanderings of said Gilders
Creek in an Easterly direction to the point of intersection of
said creek with the West line of the Simpsonville Road, the
point of beginning, the said tract of land containing 28.50 acres.
