Dollars, to be paid January 2, 1922.

with interest thereon from annually 8 per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid.

until paid in full, all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount contained by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who  
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten per cent besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to  
the amount due on said note to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part  
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference  
being thereunto made, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I the said J.F. Vaughan  
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said note

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said  
J.F. Vaughan

in hand well and truly paid by the said  
W.T. Jones

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do  
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said W.T. Jones, and his heirs and assigns forever, All that certain

piece, parcel and tract of land situated in the State and County aforesaid, on Gilder  
Creek, waters of Enoree River in Augtin Township, adjoining lands of L.A. Fowler  
William Mahaffey, T.B. Waters and others, being a part of tract of land deeded W.A.-  
Adams by C.J. Hill by deed dated Dec. 20th, 1877 and recorded in Book I.I., page  
445 and having the following metes and bounds to wit:-

Beginning on iron pin in Mill Road on the old line of the above mentioned tract and runs  
thence with said road S. 10 W. 14.32 chains to angle in road; thence S. 21 1/2 E. 3.40  
to angle; thence N. 89-3/4 E. 1.90 to angle; thence N. 62 E. 3.20 to iron pin on  
bluff, near the Mill House; thence S. 18-3/4 E. crossing the Creek 2.84 to iron pin in  
old road; thence with said old road N. 61 E. 2.82 to iron pin in angle of road; thence  
N. 38 1/2 W. 30 links to center of Gilder Creek; thence down the meanderings of said  
Creek as a line about twenty one chains to old line of T.R. League, Est; thence with  
said line N. 12 E. 4.50 to stone; thence N. 71 W. 27.20 to the beginning corner,  
containing twenty-eight and one-quarter acres, more or less, and being the same tract  
of land deeded to me by W.A. Adams, Dec. 31, 1918 and recorded Feby. 13, 1919 Vol. 34  
page 326.
