I, Walter Thompson SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, Walter Thompson
in and by W certain Promissory note in writing, of
even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to

Minnie Hunt
in the full and just sum of One hundred and twenty-five and no/100
Dollars, to be paid August 13th, 1922

with interest thereon from date at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

fifty and no/100 besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, Walter Thompson
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

Minnie Hunt
according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said

Walter Thompson
in hand well and truly paid by the said

Minnie Hunt
at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Minnie Hunt, her heirs and assigns all that cert in piece,

parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County
of Greenville and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:-
Beginning at an iron pin on the east side of Palmetto Avenue 368.6 feet from the intersec-
tion of Palmetto Avenue and Haynie Street, joint corner lots 76 and 77 and running thence
with line of lot No. 77, N. 79 E. ninety feet to an iron pin on Chapin Avenue; thence with
Chapin Avenue S. 14-10 E. fifty feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner lots Nos. 75 and 76;
thence with the line of Lots No. 75 E. 79 E. ninety three feet to an iron pin on Palmetto
Avenue; thence with Palmetto Avenue N. 11 W. fifty feet to the point of beginning. Being
Lot No. 76 conveyed to Minnie Hunt by deed dated February 25th, 1920 by West End Land
and Improvement Co., the said deed recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County
in deed book 61, page 15.

mortgage is given to secure the balance of the purchase price of the said lot.
